- Rink: Smead Arena (Blunt Park), 1780 Roosevelt Avenue, Springfield, MA 01109
The rink measures 85 x 190 with rounded corners
- Deadline: All entries must be postmarked no later than **October 26, 2011**. Late entries will be accepted only if time permits, and if accompanied by a late fee of \$20.00.
- Test/Age: Test Status and age is effective as of the deadline date, October 26, 2011
- Eligibility: Events are open to all amateur skaters who are members in good standing of U.S. Figure Skating and meet their requirements. Eligibility is based on test level as of the deadline date. In each category, skaters may skate at highest level passed OR one level higher, BUT NOT both levels in the same event during the same competition.
- Entries: Applications will be handled on a first come, first served basis. Late entries will be accepted ONLY if time permits. Events will be cancelled due to the lack of entries and refunds will be issued. LSV reserves the right to combine groups if entries warrant.
- Fees: All fees must accompany the entry form and are payable to Little Sun Valley SC. Returned checks will be assessed a \$20.00 fee per check. All entry fees are non-refundable after the deadline date according to 2011 – 2012 USFS rule #3047.

- Judging: 6.0 Judging System will be used for all events.
- Schedule: The schedule will be available approximately 1 week prior to the competition date and will be published on the LSV website: <http://www.littlesunvalleyskating.org>. Hard copies will be mailed to competitors who send a **self-addressed, stamped envelope**. Skaters should check in at least 60 minutes prior to their events.
- Music: Original CD is required and a backup is recommended. CD should be turned in at the registration desk; program must be the only music on the CD. Music should be clearly labeled with skater's name, event and club.
- Awards: Medals will be awarded to 1st, 2nd and 3rd place finishers in each event.

WELL-BALANCED FREE SKATE PROGRAM

Skaters may enter EITHER the Test Track Free Skate program or the Well-Balanced Free Skate program, but **NOT** both during the same non-qualifying competition. Skater may skate at highest test level passed OR one level higher BUT NOT both levels in the same event during the same competition. Competitors will skate to music of their choice. **Please see the 2011 - 2012 USFS Rulebook for specific program requirements.**

TEST TRACK PROGRAM

Skaters may enter EITHER the test track free skate program or the well-balanced track free skate program, but **NOT** both during the same non-qualifying competition. Competitor may skate at highest test level passed OR one level higher, BUT NOT both in the same event during the same competition. Competitors will skate to music of their choice; vocal music permitted

Deductions WILL be made for skaters including technical elements not permitted in the event description

- * 0.1 from EACH mark for each technical element included that is not permitted in the event description
- * 0.2 from the technical mark for each extra or lacking element
- * 0.1 for any spin with less than required revolutions

INDIVIDUAL COMPULSORY MOVES

Test levels for this event are based on the Freeskating tests passed (or adult equivalent). Skater may skate at highest test level passed or one higher. The program will be skated without music on ½ ice. Elements may be skated in any order and connecting steps may be included, but should be limited to the minimum necessary to link the various moves. Boys and girls may be combined in the same event. All programs may be no more than 1-½ minutes.

INTERPRETIVE

Test levels for this event are based on the Freeskating tests passed (or adult equivalent). Skater may skate at highest test level passed or one higher. Music chosen by the competition committee; skaters will hear music during the warm up. Skaters will be judged on interpretation of the rhythm and character of the music, edges, footwork and timing of jumps and spins.

Coaching is not permitted. No double or triple jumps allowed (regardless of level). Boys & girls may be combined in the same event; event levels may be combined based on number of competitors and/or timing of competition.

Events:	No Test / Beginner through Senior levels
Program Length:	1:00 to 1:30 minutes for all levels

SHOWCASE

Test levels for this event are based on the Freeskating tests passed (or adult equivalent). Skater may skate at highest test level passed or one higher. All programs are to be judged for originality, musical interpretation, costumes, audience appeal and choreography. Vocal music is permitted. Show costumes are permitted, as long as they do not touch or drag on the ice. Props must be placed and removed unaided by competitor as quickly as possible (max allowed time of 1 min.). Boys and girls may be combined in the same event; events levels may be combined based on number of competitors and/or timing of competition.

SOLO DANCE

Skaters may skate at highest test level passed or one higher. Boys and girls may be combined in the same event. Three patterns will be skated.

Silver	Passed 1 – 3 Silver Dances, no higher Dance: Rocker Foxtrot
Adult Bronze	Passed the complete standard, adult or masters preliminary test and no higher than one standard adult or masters pre-silver dance Dance: Ten Fox
Adult Silver	Passed the complete standard, adult or masters pre-silver test and no higher than one standard adult or masters pre-gold dance Dance: European Waltz
Adult Gold	Passed at least one standard adult or masters pre-gold dance Dance: Quickstep

TEAM COMPULSORY MOVES

Test levels for this event are based on the Freeskating tests passed (or adult equivalent). Skating up one level is allowed. Teams may consist of 3 – 5 skaters. Boys and girls may be placed on the same team. To be skated on full ice.

Preliminary	Loop jump; Flip jump; Waltz jump-Toe loop jump; Forward spiral; Sit spin
Juvenile	Axel; Single-single jump combination (no axel); Spiral sequence with at least two changes of position; Layback; Combination spin with one change of foot / one change of position.

ADULT COMPULSORY MOVES EVENTS – ADULT PRE-BRONZE THROUGH GOLD

Test levels for this event are the same as the Adult program event. Skaters may skate at highest test level passed or one level higher. The skating order of the required elements is optional. The elements are not restricted as to the number of times element is executed, or length of glides, number of revolutions, etc., unless otherwise stated. Connecting moves and steps should be demonstrated throughout the program. Must be 21 years or older for the following events. All programs may be no more than 1 ½ minutes.

- Program will be skated without music on ½ ice
- The skater must demonstrate the required elements and may use, but is not required to use, any additional elements from previous levels

ADULT PROGRAM EVENTS – ADULT PRE-BRONZE THROUGH GOLD

Skaters may skate at highest test level passed or one level higher. Vocal music is allowed; the skater must demonstrate the required elements and may use, but is not required to use, any additional elements from previous levels. A 0.2 deduction will be taken for each element performed from a higher level

Adult Pre-Bronze Time: 1:40 max. Must have passed no higher than adult pre-bronze free skate test or pre-pre free skate test. Refer to current US Figure Skating Rulebook #3805 for specific requirements	Adult Bronze Time: 1:50 max. Must have passed no higher than adult bronze free skate test or the preliminary free skate test. Refer to the current U.S. Figure Skating Rulebook #3801 for specific requirements
Adult Silver Time: 2:10 max. Must have passed no higher than adult silver free skate test or pre-juvenile free skate test. Refer to current US Figure Skating Rulebook #3791 for specific requirements	Adult Gold Time: 2:40 max. Must have passed no higher than adult gold free skate test or the juvenile free skate test.
